Admission Process and Classroom Facilities

The admission process for the third batch of students is currently underway. There are three more classrooms needed for the next academic sessions. We need two more teachers for Law and one teacher for English (Part time) for next academic year.

Other Operational Expenses

Several essential operational costs, such as electricity, stationery, internet, library books, postage, and generator diesel, are being covered by the college itself. These expenses are necessary for the smooth functioning of the institution. The salary of teachers for the academic year 2024-25 will be paid from the college funds. The payments will be covered until February 2025.

College Campus Construction and Approvals

The construction of the college campus is still in progress, and necessary paperwork for approval has been submitted. The approval from the town planner has been received, but the final approval from the Panchayat is still pending. Once the Panchayat grants its approval, the construction work will commence immediately to complete the remaining infrastructure.
